



BOAT OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES INCLEMENT WEATHER CONDITIONS AND HURRICANE PREPARATION

Great Bay Marine has a Storm Management Plan in place in the event of a significant storm or hurricane.

It is the boat owner's responsibility to monitor weather conditions. Boat owners are responsible for securing their vessel in inclement weather. If unable to do so, please notify the service department at 603-436-5299 ext. 16 or service@greatbaymarine.com to make arrangements. We try to minimize any effect a storm will have on our marina and your boat.

The following is recommended to secure the vessel:

- Reduce the windage by removing all sails, canvas covers, bimini tops and all removable topside equipment.
- Deflate inflatable dinghies and store safely. Rigid dinghies should be removed from the dinghy area and secured away from wind exposure.
- All electric and water connections must be disconnected and stored on board.
- The vessel should be tied with heavy-duty line and line doubled up where possible. There is a minimum of two lines on bow and stern, and two spring lines fore and aft. If GBM personnel determine the lines are inadequate, the lines will be replaced at the customer's expense.
- The bow should be facing the river, where possible.
- All preparations should be complete before the arrival of a storm.
- If you are unable to secure your vessel, please notify Great Bay Marine as soon as possible.
